Mobile Welfare Van

Problem:

C704 project covers various locations across London from Paddington in the west to Pudding Mill Lane and Plumstead in the east. One of the challenges of working on different sites and infrastructures is travelling from one site to another on a nightly basis where adequate welfare facilities may not be available.

Solution:

Providing sites with mobile welfare GARIC vans to ensure welfare needs/requirements are met, these should only be used where existing facilities are not accessible.

Advantages:

- Provides welfare requirements for up to seven people
- Includes resting area, hot and cold water, microwave oven and a fully-flushing private WC, complete with self-servicing discharge system.
