Shoulder Pad Showcase

Problem:

The project C704 has progressed from the maintenance phase, to decommissioning; leading to a rise in manual handling activities. Efforts have been made to address this through the use of mechanical means, but in some cases, manual handling is unavoidable.

Solution:

The use of shoulder pads, specially designed with industrial strength materials to provide a cushion/padding between the shoulder and the item being carried, i.e. a scaffold tube.

Advantages:

- Can be worn on either shoulder.
- Easily adjustable to fit around any size.
- Can be worn underneath high visibility clothing to ensure operative is still PPE compliant.
