WELCOME

On behalf of the Crossrail team working at Whitechapel I'd like to thank our neighbours for their continued support. Here are my highlights of the work we have completed so far and details of our plans for the next six months.

READY FOR FIT-OUT

With the station structure now substantially complete, work at Whitechapel has turned to the fit-out of the new concourse and platforms. Over the coming months, activities will focus on installing railway systems and the station's architectural finishes.

Under ground, the team are fitting the key infrastructure that will connect the new station to the rest of the network. The first of the fibre optic communication cables has been placed beneath the westbound platform, and the cable routes for the high voltage electric cables that will provide power to the station are now in position. Work has also started to install 3,000 lights throughout the platforms and shafts.

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

1 Westbound platform completed

Work to construct Whitechapel's westbound platform is now complete which marks the start of railway systems installation. The first sections of rail are being installed into the westbound tunnel and work will commence in the eastbound tunnel over the coming months.

2 Station structure reaches 90% complete

Construction of the station's steel concourse has reached 90% completion marking a major milestone for Whitechapel station. A total of 1,080 tonnes of structural steel has now been installed which allows for cladding to commence. The remainder of the roof skeleton will be completed in February 2017.


Work coming up at Whitechapel in the next six months

- Continued construction of station concourse
- External cladding of Durward Street and Cambridge Heath Road head houses
- Mechanical and electrical fit out
- Installation of ventilation fans
- Cladding of station platforms
- Installation of railway track
- Completion of station roof

COMMUNITY INVESTMENT IN WHITECHAPEL
