### **Crossrail Programme, Gidea Park Update**

Network Rail is undertaking essential improvement works in your area to prepare for the start of Crossrail services. We are improving stations and infrastructure to allow more frequent and reliable services to operate and provide a better travelling experience for passengers. The following information is a summary of planned works in your area.

#### **Cambridge Avenue Worksite**

Date and Time	Description of works
July to September 2016 Daytime working Monday to Saturday: 08:00 -18:00 (08:00 – 13:00 Sat)	During July 2016 we will install the concrete bases for the power supply and equipment buildings that will be permanently located within our worksite at Cambridge Avenue. This work will be during core daylight hours, some noise will be generated, in particular when we are installing ducting routes within the site for the power supply cables.
Weekends Typically 23:59hrs Sat to 05:00hrs Mon	Construction of under track cable crossings, troughing routes and concrete bases for signalling equipment will continue. We do not anticipate significant noise levels to be generated by these activities and they will mainly be carried out during daylight hours, Monday to Friday. Some weekend working will be necessary for safety reasons.

#### **Gidea Park Station Works**

June to October 2016	The footbridge structure has been stripped of rust and old paint. Repairs and reinforcement works are ongoing and a

Weekends Typically 23:59hrs Sat to 05:00hrs Mon Some daytime working will also take place Mon to Sat: 08:00 -18:00 (08:00 – 13:00 Sat)	new roof will be fitted. Once repairs are complete the scaffolding and plastic encapsulation will be removed from the exterior of the footbridge, currently scheduled for September 2016.
October to December 2016 Weekends Typically 23:59hrs Sat to 05:00hrs Mon	Construction of two lift shafts from the footbridge to the platforms involves driving steel piles into the ground using either a vibrating, hammer or auger method. Hammer piling, being the loudest, will only be used during daylight hours.
June to December 2016 Weekends Typically 23:59hrs Sat to 05:00hrs Mon	Platform extension works at the eastern end of the station continue, our site team are installing blockwork foundations with concrete beams to form the platform structure.

We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause. Whilst we do anticipate some of these works to be noisy at times, measures are in place to keep noise levels to a minimum. Due to works taking place on operational railway, much of our work has to be carried out at night and weekends when trains are not running for safety reasons.

The local authority has been, and will continue to be, consulted through the Control of Pollution Act 1974 (Section 61) process regarding the implementation of the works.
