# WORKS UPDATE

## WELCOME

On behalf of the Crossrail team working at Paddington I'd like to thank our neighbours for their continued support.

Here are my highlights of the work we have completed so far and details of our plans for the next six months.

## KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

### 1 Completed structural works

Structural work is complete on the main station structure including platforms, flared elliptical columns, and ventilation head houses. The completion of the overall structure means activities will focus on the mechanical, electrical and architectural fit out of the station.

### 2 Handover of station rooms

Eight rooms within the new Crossrail Paddington station have now been constructed. A further 40 rooms will be built by December 2016 and a total of 300,000 metres of cable pulled through the station building.

## INSTALLATION OF ARCHITECTURAL FINISHES

Work at Paddington is now focused on installing the station's architectural finishes and systems.

Architectural features of the station design such as the brick slip panels which will line the walls of the ticket halls can now be seen. Work has also started on the bronze cladding of concrete columns and walls.

Excavation will soon commence in Departures Road to build foundations for the 90 metre-long steel and glass canopy that will cover the station platform. This activity involves constructing the canopy base and drainage systems in preparation for building the complete structure next year.

The remainder of work will focus on the fit out of over 40 rooms with the power, communications, ventilation and signalling systems to transform the new space into an operational station.



- Mechanical and electrical fit out works
- Installation of architectural finishes
- Installation of escalators and glass lift
- Installation of ventilation equipment
- Excavation works for the station canopy's foundations
